National Professional Qualification for Early Years Leadership (NPQEYL)

Great leadership is the foundation upon which a world-class education system is built.

Great Leadership

At the heart of great leadership is shared, evidence-informed understanding of what works. A child's experiences between birth and age five have a major impact on their future life chances.

The NPQEYL aims to support early years leaders to continuously develop their knowledge and skills throughout their careers so every child gets the best start in life.

With this in mind, in Ealing, we strongly encourage all of our early years leaders in early years settings (childminders, children centres, PVIs and schools) to study towards gaining the **National Professional Qualification for Early Years Leadership (NPQEYL)**.

Target Audience

The target group for the NPQ for Early Years Leadership is leaders qualified to **at least level 3** with a full and relevant qualification who are, or are aspiring to be:

- managers or aspiring managers of private, voluntary and independent nurseries
- childminders with leadership responsibilities
- leaders with a full level 3 qualification or above
- headteachers of school-based or maintained nurseries
- school-based class teachers who are, or are aspiring to be, year group / EYFS leaders

National Professional Qualifications for Early Years (NPQEYL)

The NPQ for Early Years Leadership complements the current suite of NPQs aimed at teachers and school leaders by providing training and support for early years practitioners, teachers and leaders, whether they work in Private, Voluntary and Independent nurseries, school-based nurseries, or as childminders. It will support practitioners, teachers and leaders to develop expertise in leading high-quality education and care, as well as effective staff and organisational management

Race Equity ‘Train-the-Trainer’ Training – for Leaders

Background

In Ealing, we are committed to empowering all our schools and early years settings with developing effective race equity practice - whether the children, families and communities that you serve are ethnically diverse or predominantly mono-cultural. That is, to ensure the positive experiences and high educational outcomes for our children who are currently under-served, including those of Black Caribbean heritage.

Doing so, will also ensure all of our children become our future anti-racist leaders and members of society, in Ealing and beyond.

Additionally, the progress for our children who are at risk of attaining lower educational outcomes during and at the end of the EYFS, is the responsibility of all, including key people, all other practitioners, parents, and early years leaders.

In Ealing, there is a cross-phase (EYFS, primary and high school) focus on the educational experiences and outcomes for Black Caribbean children; which is also linked to the outcomes of Ealing’s Independent Race Equality Commission: [ealing-race-equality-commission-final-report-27-january-2022.pdf \(dosomethinggood.org.uk\)](https://dosomethinggood.org.uk/wp-content/uploads/2022/01/ealing-race-equality-commission-final-report-27-january-2022.pdf)

We know you take much pride in your commitment and delivery of your early years practice for all your children. With this in mind, we know that you want to ensure that every child in your school/early years setting experiences unapologetically high expectations, aspirations, experiences and outcomes, regardless of their ethnicity - and that *‘no learner is left behind’*.

Training Approach

To contribute to the **swift and positive impact** we are all seeking for our children who are currently under-served (including those of Black Caribbean heritage), this academic year, we are striving for **every** early years setting to deliver **whole-setting race equity training**, via pre-recorded videos, to their staff teams – at a time that suits them.

The whole-setting training that leaders will deliver to their staff teams will consist of 4 x 1hr 15 min pre-recorded video training sessions.

Two people from each early years setting (including the setting leader) are to attend a **1-day** train-the-trainer course to enable them to effectively facilitate discussions in their own settings, at the key 'pause' points of the pre-recorded race equity training videos.

Training Aims

- Leaders will be confident to effectively facilitate discussions in their own settings, at the key points of the pre-recorded race equity training videos
- Settings will be become empowered with the confidence and knowledge to recognise and dismantle racism and bias; including the impact on our children in the early years
- The training will act as a springboard for developing highly effective race equity practice in the early years

SEND Leadership Training

In Ealing, we are committed to ensuring that SEND is everyone's responsibility, and that effective leadership skills are developed at all levels within our early years settings. That is, irrespective of qualification levels or the practitioners' / leaders' level of seniority within an early years school or setting.

The progress of our children most vulnerable to delay is the responsibility of all, including key people, all other practitioners, parents, SENCOs, specialist's and early years leaders.

To contribute to the **swift and positive impact** we are all seeking for our children with SEND, this academic year, we are striving for every early years setting to participate in **2 days** (10 hours) of **whole-setting SEND Leadership INSET (ONLINE)**.

This multi-agency course will provide you with the foundations to build whole-setting support for children with SEND. The previous 5-part course will continue to be delivered during the spring and summer terms.

Please note:

- We recognise that whole-setting impact is slower when individuals access training individually (as opposed to via whole-staff teams).
- The SEND Leadership training can be attended as a stand-alone course or as one of the requirements of the '*Inspirational Settings Programme*' (page 56).

Aims:

- To develop the foundation for a **whole-setting approach** for **effective inclusive SEND practice** in the early years.
- To contribute to the **swift and positive impact** in all of our early years settings for our children with SEND – that we are all seeking
- The **two consecutive INSET days** (end of Summer or beginning of Autumn 2022) will give our children and staff the best possible start for the new academic year
- The **5-part course** (Spring and Summer 2023) will then continue to be available during the spring and summer terms for those delegates who:

- join their settings after the autumn term's whole-setting training has been delivered and / or
- were unable to attend the autumn term whole-setting training for any reason

This Consecutive Two-Day or Five-Part Course (same content):

- This practical and interactive course will support your understanding in:
 - Ealing's SEN support in line with the government expectations as outlined in the SEND Code of Practice (14/15)
 - High-quality teaching and inclusive practice including targeted and specialist support
 - The four broad areas of SEND
 - The importance of high-quality referrals and the graduated approach
 - The strategies and interventions that are most effective with children who have SEND
 - The importance of collaborative working with families, colleagues and Ealing services
 - How you might effectively influence effective SEND practice with the other practitioners and leaders in your setting

Please note:

- Whole-staff teams and / or individuals must be available to attend all the dates of this course (whether the 2 consecutive INSET days or the 5-part course) to receive their certificate(s);
- Delegates cannot transfer to any of the other SEND Leadership course dates.

Course Prerequisites:

- This course is aimed at practitioners working with children between the ages of birth and 5 years of age.

Course Objectives:

- Define SEND and inclusion in an early years context.
- Raise awareness of the SEND Code of Practice including the Graduated Approach, the Local Offer and the four broad areas of SEND.
- Learn about the different specialists and services within Ealing responsible for SEN support including Speech & Language Therapy, Occupational Therapy and the Family Information Service.
- Develop greater understanding and empathy with families of children with SEND by hearing real life examples of their journey and experiences.

- Raise awareness of the SEND toolkit and encourage practitioners to build upon their universal and targeted provision back in settings.
- Encourage collaborative partnerships with children, families, colleagues and other services where each knows their accountability in securing progress and each has a voice.
- Experience a Team Around the Family (TAF) assessment and to receive feedback about what you have learnt and how you have demonstrated this knowledge.
- Commit to, and identify how, delegates might effectively influence effective SEND practice with the other practitioners and leaders in their setting.

Autism Awareness Training for Early Years Practitioners

The course:

- This session:
 - is designed for early years practitioners working with children 0-5 years.
 - provides foundation information for early years practitioners on Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD).
 - focuses on how early years practitioners can support the child with ASD in a nursery setting.

Course Objectives

By the end of this session, you will:

- Have an understanding of Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD)
- Be able to identify potential signs of ASD
- Know how to raise concerns to families about children you are working with

EYFS Collaborative Hubs

In spring / summer 2022, a small group of early years leaders piloted the formation of an online EYFS Collaborative Hub: *'Outdoor Play in all Weathers'*.

This academic year, EYFS Collaborative Hubs have been expanded to include many other aspects of early years practice.

Aims

The aims of the EYFS Collaborative Hubs are for our early years leaders to **co-develop, share, align and sustain**:

1. **Highly inspirational** early years education and leadership within and between our early years settings (Childminders, Children Centres and PVI's) and schools:
 - Locality-based
 - Cross-locality
 - Nationally & globally
2. **High educational outcomes and closed gaps for all children**, and thus ensure that the start of every child's learning journey, from the EYFS, is successful for all learners – irrespective of ethnicity; those with SEND, different starting points; and the lowest 20% or 10%
3. **Sector-led and self-sustaining** collaborative partnerships, that centre on:
 - The original focus of this hub
 - Emerging needs-led and / or enquiry-led foci
4. **Content development** regarding highly inspirational practice that is research-driven and worthy of dissemination locally, nationally and globally

NB: It is envisaged that eventually hubs will engage in joint practice-based visits to each other's settings

Safer Recruitment Training

The course:

This full day course is an accredited course with 'The Safer Recruitment Consortium.'

Attendees must attend the entire day and complete all 4 sessions including a short assessment at the end of the training to show competency in learnt knowledge.

Session 1 looks at how safer recruitment fits with the wider context of safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children, the scale of abuse, a model of offender behaviour, some of the recurring themes in high profile professional abuse cases and how child sex abusers typically operate within organisations, and relate that to recruitment.

Session 2 illustrates the importance of planning a recruitment exercise, sending the right messages to potential applicants, following a consistent and thorough process to obtain relevant information about each applicant, and short-listing candidates for interview.

Session 3 considers the importance of making the right decisions and using structured interviews to help do that, as well as pre-employment checks on the candidate selected for appointment.

Session 4 examines the need for ongoing awareness and vigilance and considers how organisations can develop and maintain an environment that deters and prevents abuse and challenges inappropriate behaviour.

Early Help Assessment Plan Training (EHAP)

Early Help Assessment Plan (EHAP) Training

The Early Help Assessment and Plan (EHAP) is the process and tool Ealing uses for professionals to support children and young people and their families, through the delivery of multi-agency, multi-disciplinary or targeted support. This is done as early as possible to tackle an emerging problem or issue before it becomes bigger, harder to address and affects the development or life chances of the child or children in the family.

The EHAP is only used when a multi-agency approach is necessary. Where one service can address the needs of the child successfully or if a family has social care involvement, an EHAP is not needed.

The Family Information Service (FIS) is the supporting service for EHAP use. The FIS give EHAP advice, register EHAPs, deliver training and supply copies of the [EHAP pack](#) which contains all the forms and guidance needed to use the process.

The Course

EHAP training aims to support professionals working with families to improve their understanding of the EHAP process in Ealing - offering children, young people and their families a simple route to multi-agency and targeted early help and support.
